MAKAZIWE MANDELA

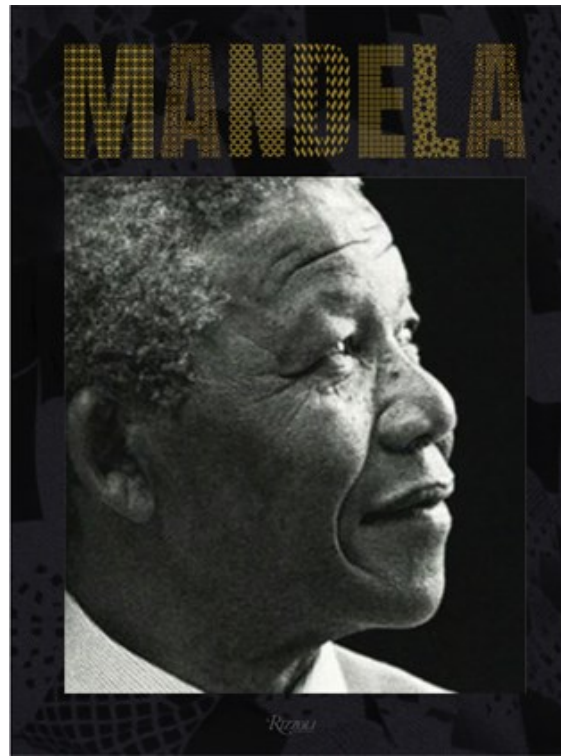
