Loretta Schauer won the Waterstones 'Picture This' competition in 2011 and has since illustrated for various publishers.

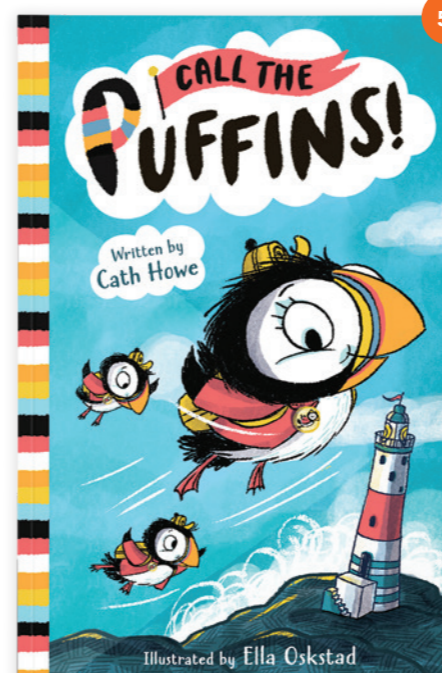

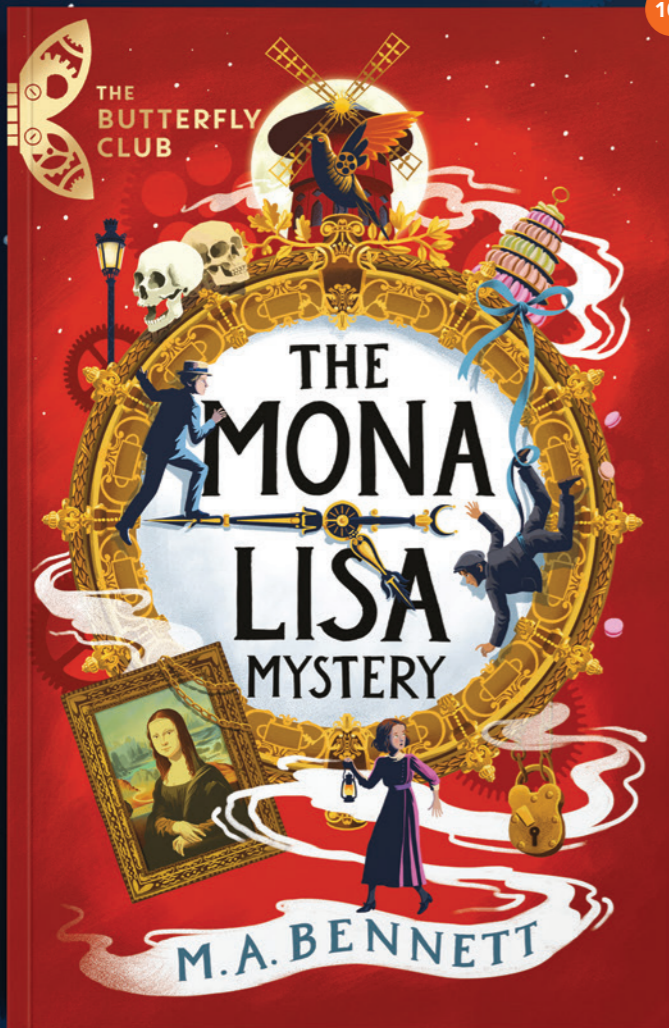

M.A. Bennett was born in the north of England to an English mother and a Venetian father. She loved history so much she studied it at four different universities. She also studied art and worked as an illustrator, an actress and a film reviewer. Now she has her dream job of being a writer and her books have been translated into more than 20 languages.

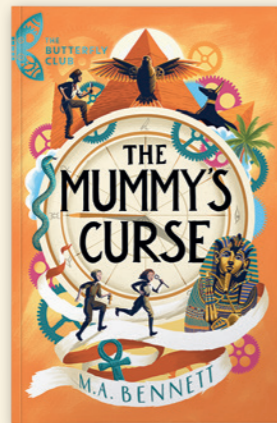

A timely and timeless tale about our fragile earth, and one girl's fierce determination to make a difference.

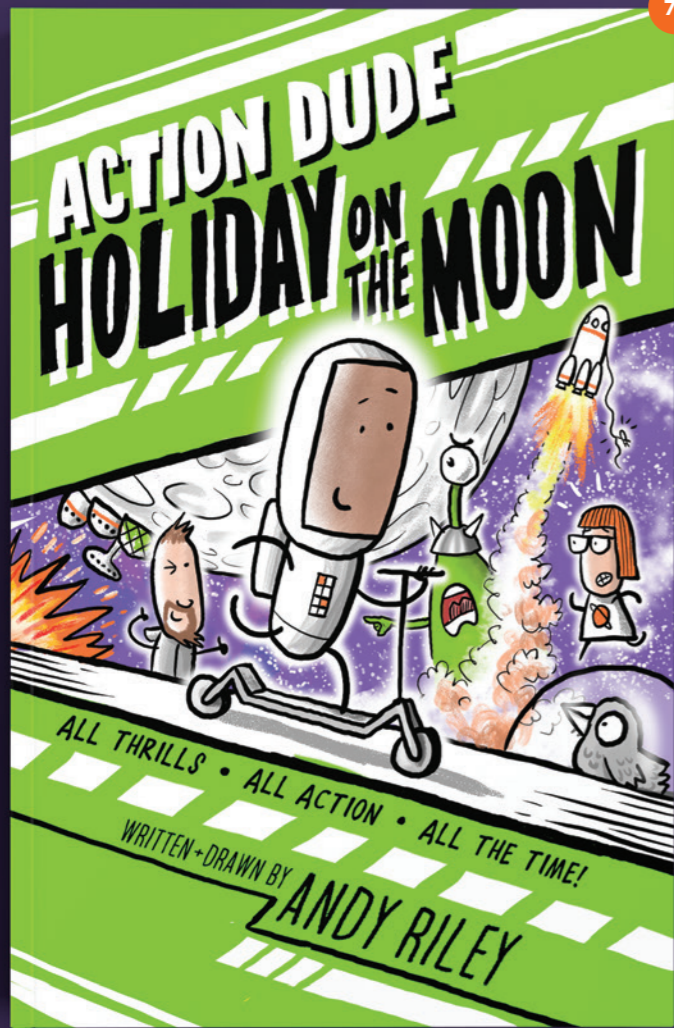

Working from the inside out, the book features targeted remedies for common problems such as sickness, headaches, sleeplessness, anxiety and poor concentration, as well as feel-good recipes to put on our bodies, around it and into the space we live.

Lizzie King has spent the last 10 years working in and learning about food, reading, writing, eating and creating recipes for her blog, *Lizzie Loves*, feeding her friends and family. Using her knowledge of ingredients as a tool to harness the power of food and keep us feeling as well as we can.

In 2020, she launched her award-winning range of supplements 'Lizzie Loves Nature's Botanicals', which have garnered love and critical acclaim and which have just launched in Holland & Barrett. There are more product lines in development.

Without any fancy decorations or presentation, Manon will share exactly how it will look in your own home.

Raised in a small village in Brittany, **Manon Legrève** grew up on a farm, where food was celebrated as the core of family life. Having spent time travelling and living in London, in 2016 Manon's passion for cooking led her to create her own lifestyle blog, *Manon's Little Kitchen*, which has a focus on achievable, positive and simplistic baking for all abilities, all influenced by her French heritage and her travels.

In 2018, Manon entered *The Great British Bake Off*, reaching the Quarter Final. Since then, she has been sharing her creations online and has nearly 160k followers on Instagram.
