Facts about different volcanoes

Volcanoes Everywhere
There are approximately 1,500 active volcanoes around the world.

Lift the flap

There are numerous volcanoes on the ocean floor. They're called submarine volcanoes.

Earth is made up of several layers. The top layer is the crust. Below it is a layer called the mantle, and deep in the center is the core.

Inside Earth, it's very hot! It can reach about 10,000° Fahrenheit (6,000° Celsius).

The plates are always on the move, although very slowly. They can pull away from each other or collide with each other.

The outer layer of Earth is made up of gigantic pieces, known as tectonic plates, that fit together like a puzzle. Most volcanoes are located where the plates meet.

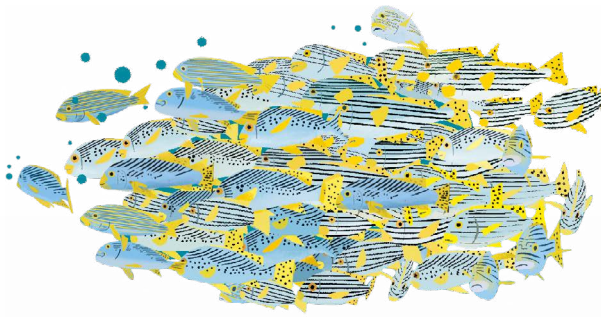
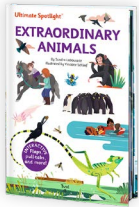
Sometimes, eruptions of a submarine volcano can form land above the water. Surtsey, an island off the coast of Iceland, was created from four years of volcanic eruptions in the 1960s.

Volcanoes that are not expected to erupt ever again are considered extinct. Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania is a volcano made up of three cones, two of which are extinct.

Some volcanoes are in the middle of a plate. One example is Piton de la Fournaise (Peak of the Furnace) on Réunion, an island in the Indian Ocean.

Dormant volcanoes, such as the ones in Auvergne, France, have not erupted in a very long time, but they may erupt again.

Active volcanoes, such as Mount Pelée in Martinique, have recently erupted and are likely to erupt again.

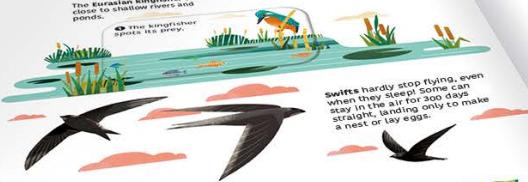
White-cheeked gibbons, which live in Asia, are agile tree dwellers that swing from branch to branch using their long forearms and flexible joints. They are also exceptional jumpers and can leap 33 feet (10 meters) from one tree to another.

Star Athletes

Swimmers, acrobats, diving, strong athletes. Their unique and their natural skills help them adapt to their environment and thrive in their environment.

The Eurasian kingfisher lives close to shallow rivers and ponds.

➔ The kingfisher dives to prey.



Swifts hardly stop flying, even when they sleep! Some can stay in the air for 100 days straight, landing only to make a nest or lay eggs.

The basilisk lizard's long feet and toes allow it to run on top of water. Young lizards can run farther and faster than adults, who often have to swim.



The purple heron is the tallest wading bird in the world. It can reach a height of 6 feet (1.8 meters) and weigh up to 15 pounds (7 kilograms).



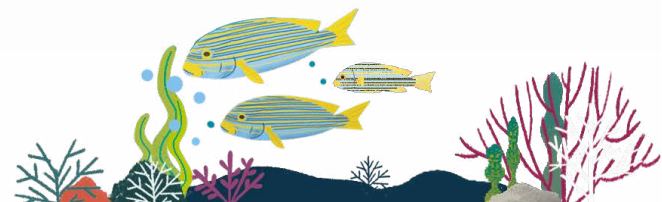
Giant tortoises are the largest living reptiles. They can live for over 100 years and weigh up to 1,500 pounds (680 kilograms).

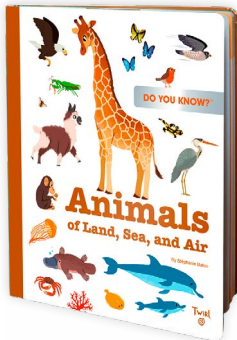


Many tarantula spider beetles have a unique defense mechanism. They can secrete a sticky substance that traps their predators.
