
This classic reference on visionary interior designer Christian Liaigre's signature style transports readers inside his world through more than six hundred photographs.

Timelessness, tranquil beauty, and subtle luxury were Liaigre's signature, and he built his reputation on the refined quality of his furniture and interiors. With a keen sensibility for space and light, design inspiration drawn from local cultures and traditions, meticulous attention given to the sourcing of materials, and an affinity for artisanal work, Liaigre combines the art of understatement with great elegance, discretion, and balance.

Christian Liaigre designed homes for Calvin Klein, Karl Lagerfeld, Bryan Adams, Rupert Murdoch, and Kenzo. He also designed the Mercer Hotel in New York and La Societé restaurant in Paris. His publications include Christian Liaigre (2008) and Christian Liaigre: Maison (2004). His home designs are available in twenty-three international showrooms including Paris, London, Brussels, Knokke-Heist, Moscow, Bangkok, Singapore, Seoul, Shanghai, Beijing, New York, Miami, Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Denver, Houston, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Scottsdale, Seattle, and Vancouver.

Art collector-dealer Heinz Berggruen amassed an exceptional collection, including works by twentieth-century masters Picasso, Klee, Matisse, and Giacometti.

Heinz Berggruen's collection—with more than one hundred masterpieces by Picasso, Klee, Matisse, and Giacometti—is a spectacular tribute to the foresight of this major player in the international art market during the second half of the twentieth century. Born into a Jewish family in Berlin in 1914, he went into exile in California on the eve of World War II. He became art critic for the San Francisco Chronicle and assistant to the director of the San Francisco MoMA. After the war, Berggruen returned to Europe, first to Munich as a journalist, then to Paris where he worked at the UNESCO headquarters before becoming an art dealer specialized in the graphic works of modern artists. He quickly established contacts within the Parisian cultural scene, meeting both the artists he would represent and the poets, dealers, historians, critics, and collectors of the day. Guided by his personal tastes, he built a remarkable collection of twentieth-century works spanning the entire careers of Picasso and Klee and including Matisse's collages and Giacometti's sculptures.

Olivier Berggruen is an independent art historian. Claire Bernardi is director of the Musée de l'Orangerie in Paris.
Blair Asbury Brooks is an art advisor and PhD candidate at The Graduate Center, City University of New York. Juliette Degennes is a heritage curator. Guillaume Fabius is conservation officer at the Musée de l'Orangerie. Alice Marsal is head of archives and documentation at the Musée de l'Orangerie. Gabriel Montua is head of Museum Berggruen.
Veronika Rudorfer is research curator at Museum Berggruen.






Jackson Pollock's "drip technique" paintings are among the most readily recognizable works of modern art.
