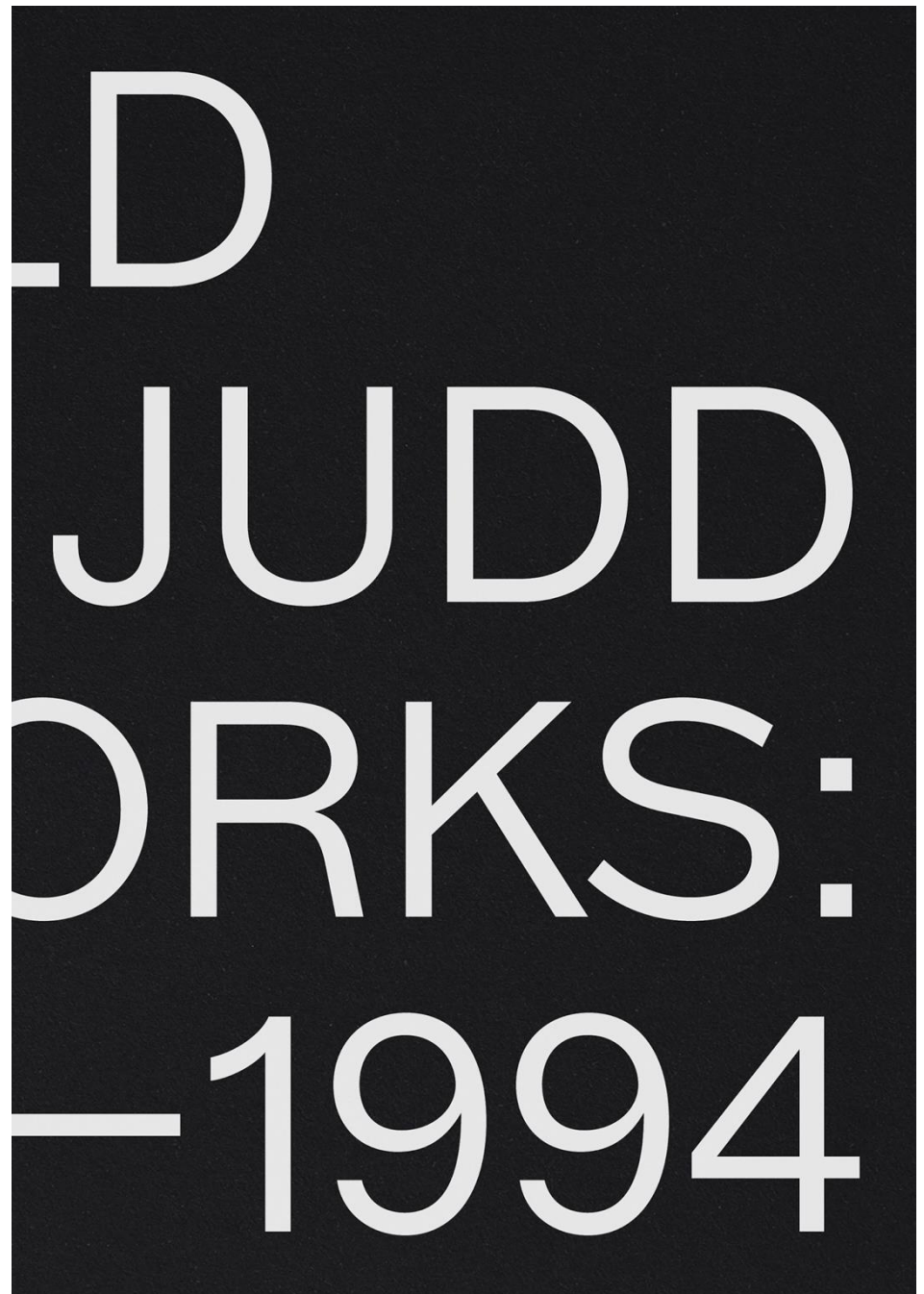

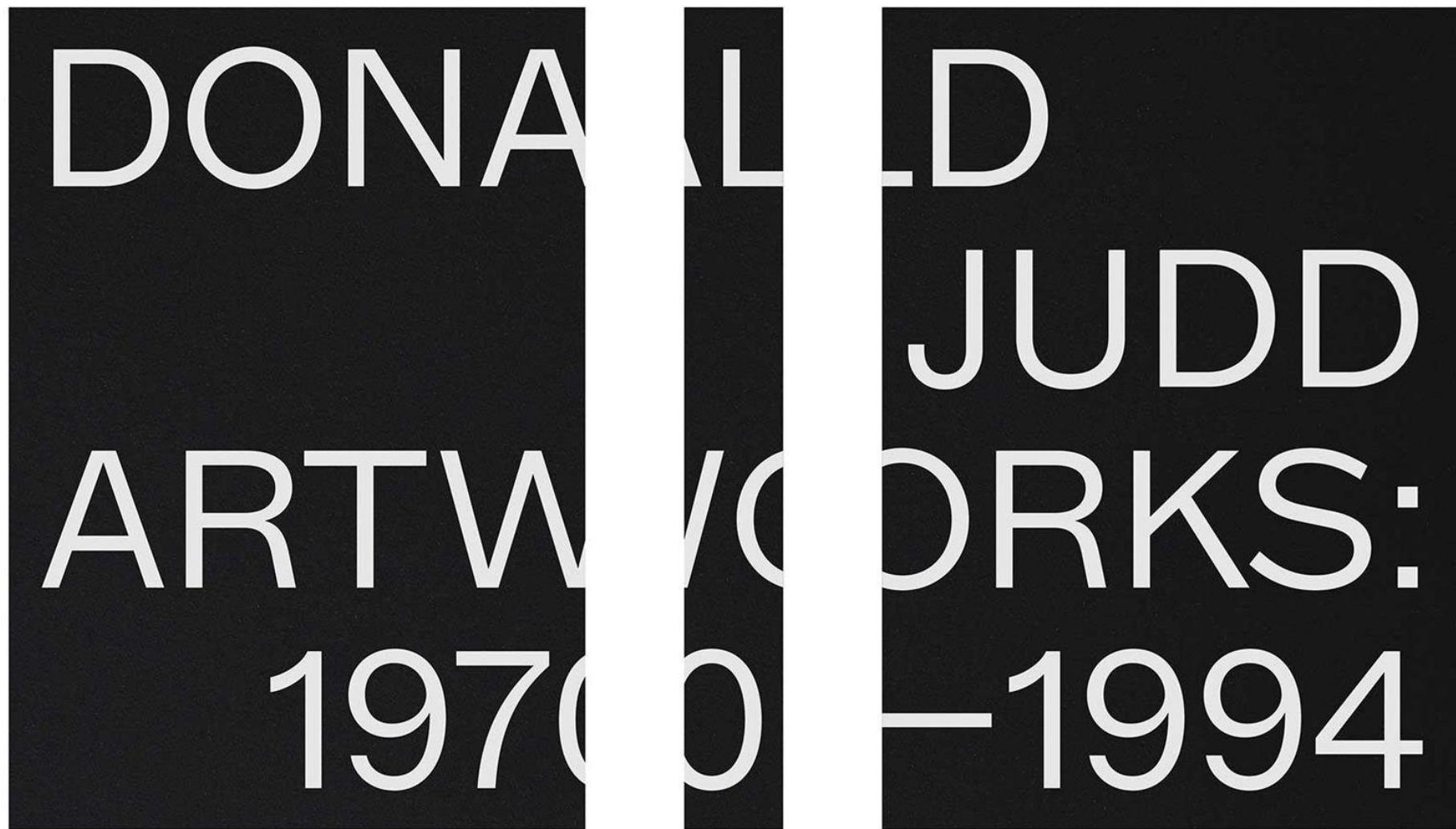

- Judd's work has been exhibited internationally since the 1950s.
- In 1986, he established The Chinati Foundation in Marfa, Texas, specifically for the permanent installation of large-scale works by both himself and his contemporaries.
