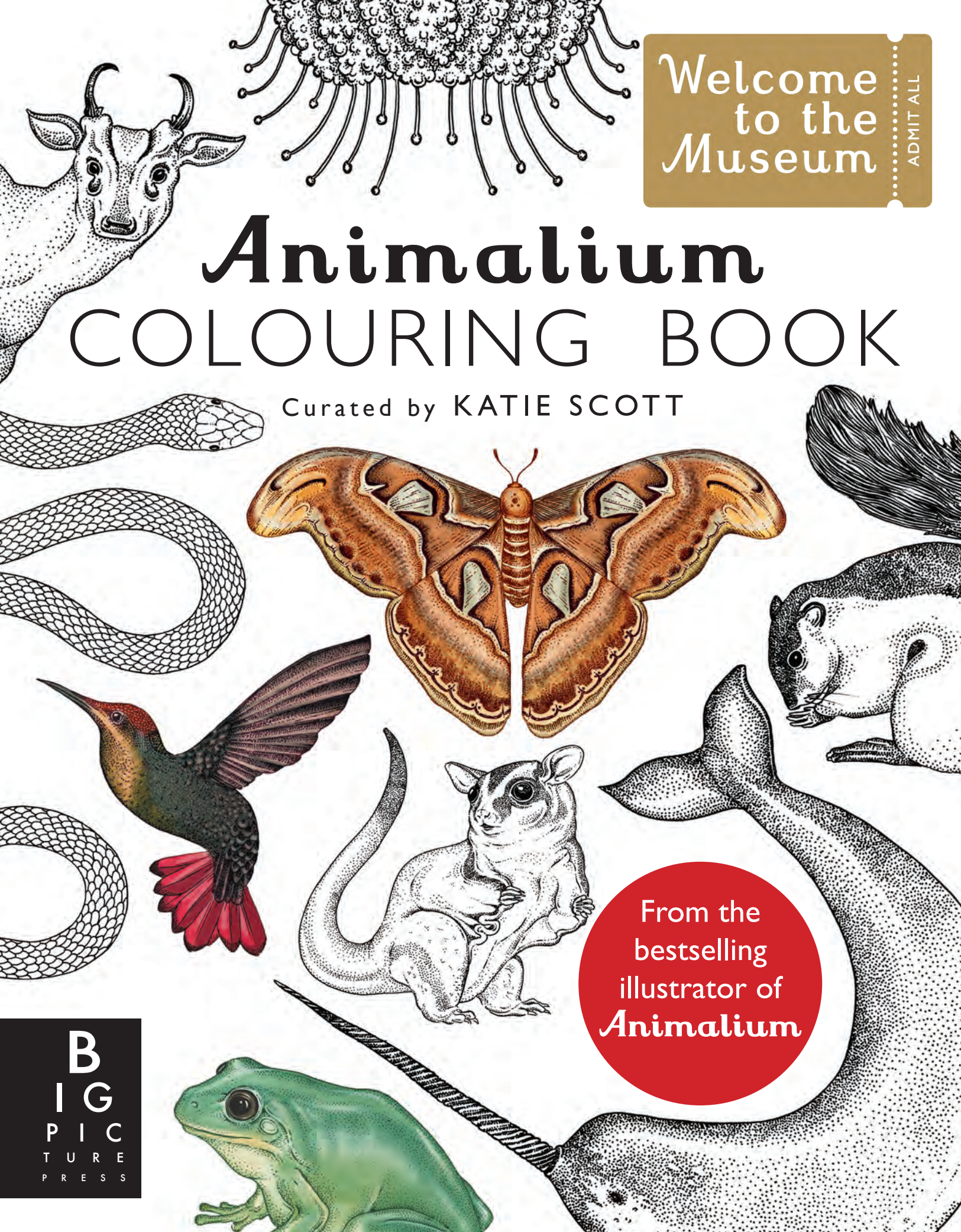

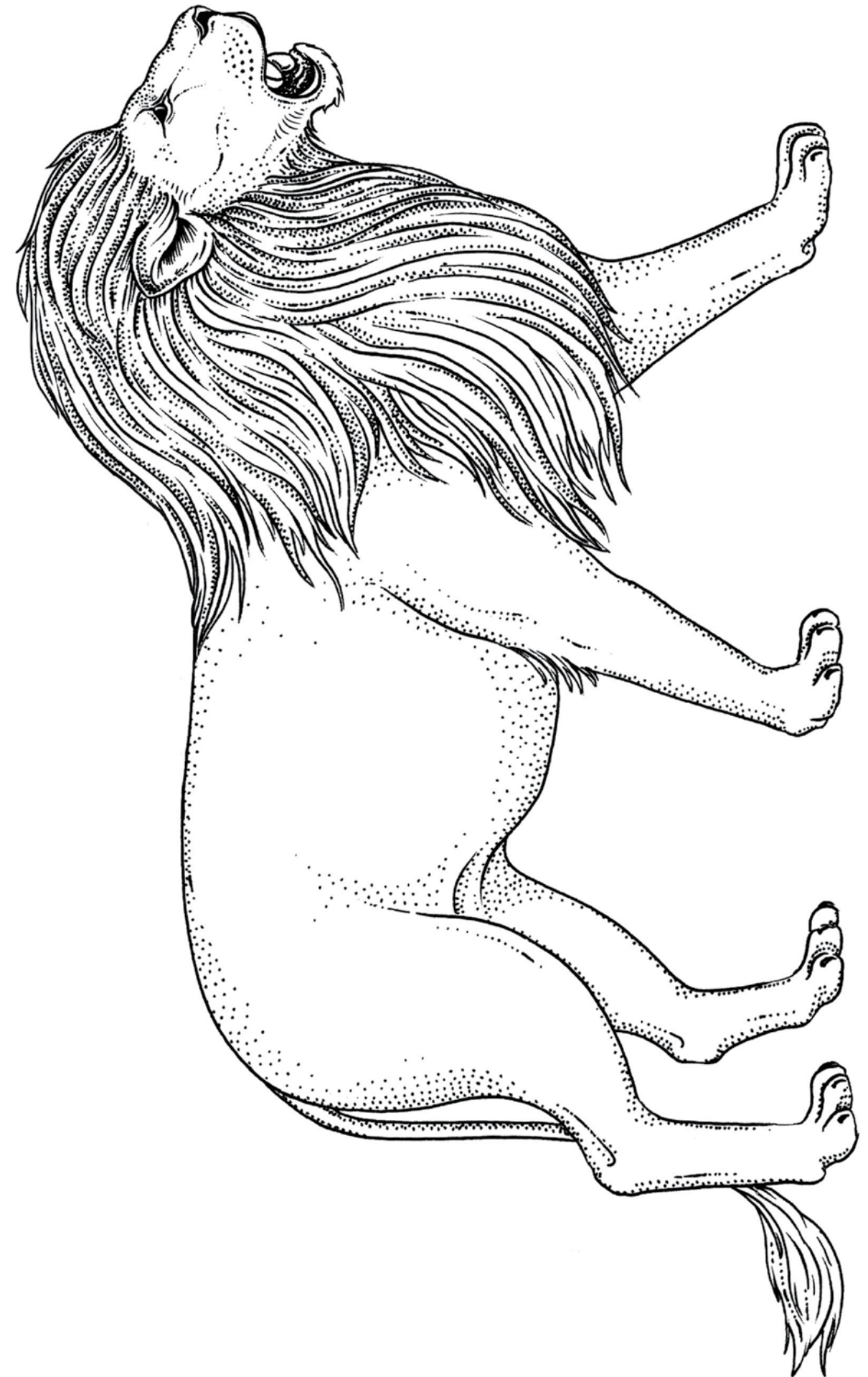

# Lions

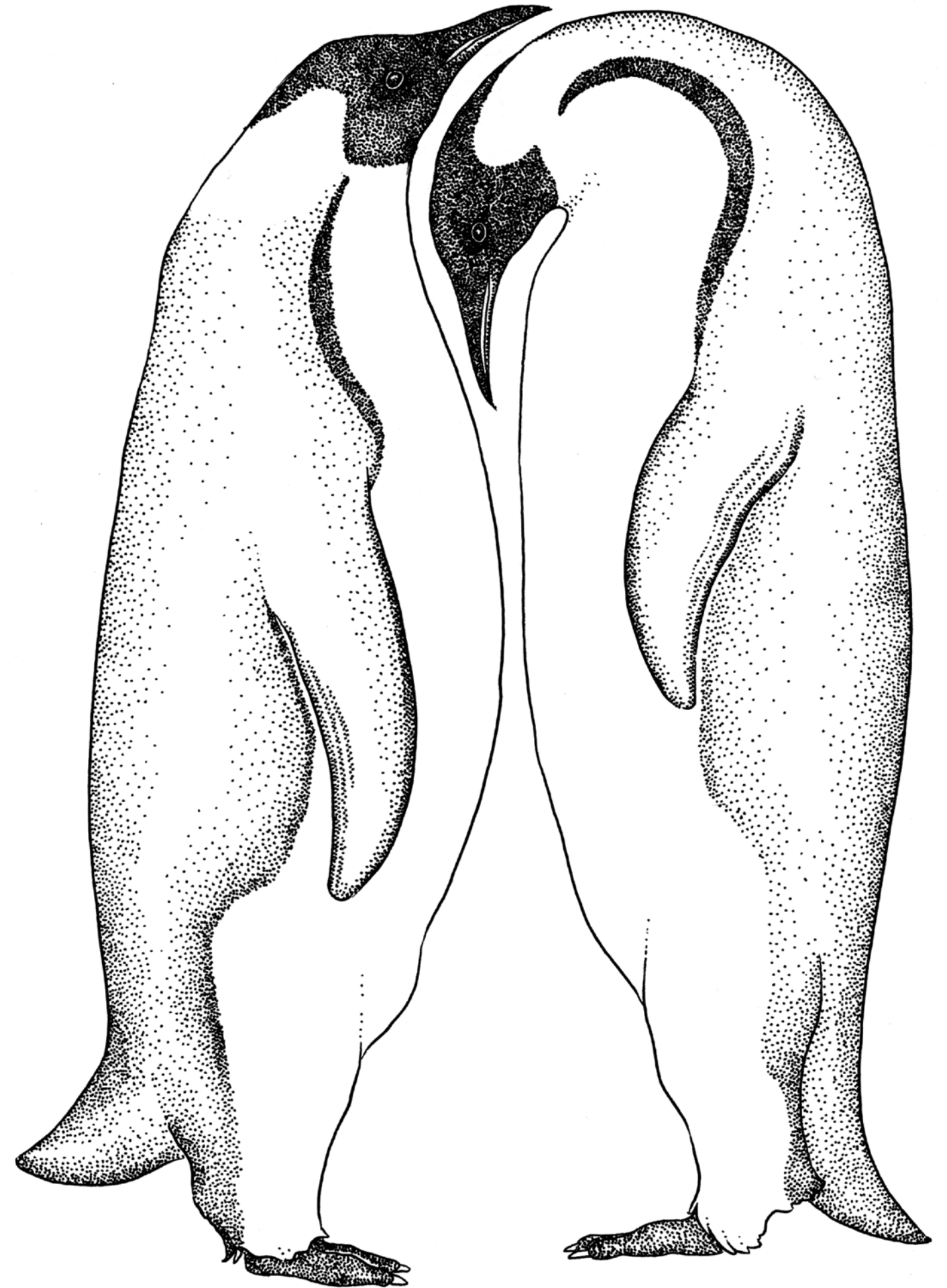

# Penguins

Ungainly on land and completely flightless, penguins are fast and agile swimmers, with large webbed feet, and wings that have adapted to act like flippers in the water. They live across the Southern Hemisphere and most species have evolved to survive in cold environments. Their feathers, densely packed and waterproof, offer excellent insulation, and their blood flow has adapted so that they do not freeze when standing on ice.
