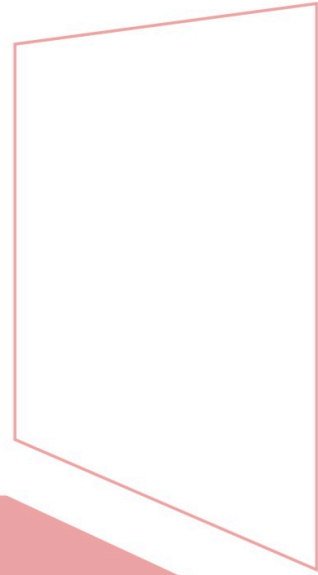
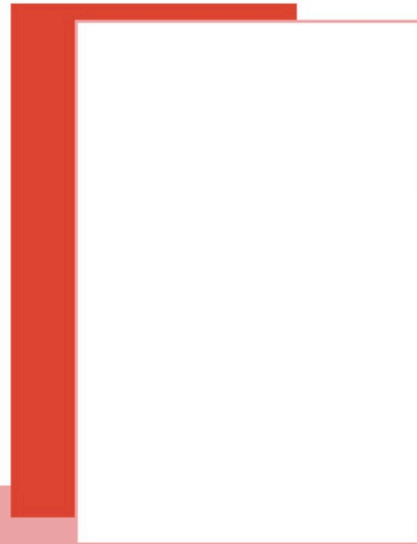
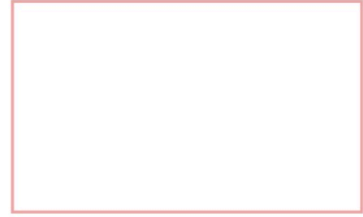
Look! It's Edvard Munch, working in his studio. Can you guess what his job is?
