

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




1 Old Man at Twilight 1918 tempera on board, 89.5 × 70.5 cm




The Man at the Window




Self-Portrait in the Studio c. 1919


5 Portrait of Hortensia, Peasant Woman from Cadaqués 1920 tempera on board, 89.5 × 70.5 cm




